RESOLUTION


WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission (CSC) revived its Program on Accreditation of Learning and Development Institutions through CSC Resolution No. 1200692 dated April 25, 2012, as amended by CSC Resolution No. 1300618 dated April 2, 2013, and CSC Resolution No. 1600770 dated July 13, 2016, which aims to build a Training Community of Practice in the civil service through mutual engagement, joint enterprise and sharing of best practices;

WHEREAS, after an evaluation of the supporting documents, conduct of ocular inspection and evaluation of the knowledge product submitted based on the set standards, contained in CSC Resolution No. 1600770 dated July 13, 2016, the Council for the Restoration of Filipino Values (CRFV) has been found to have satisfactorily met all the accreditation requirements and qualified to conduct training programs on areas or fields indicated in its Certificate of Accreditation;

WHEREFORE, the Commission **RESOLVES** to grant accreditation to the COUNCIL FOR THE RESTORATION OF FILIPINO VALUES (CRFV) with business address at 24 Naguilan Road, Kayang Extension, Baguio City, which shall be covered by the following provisions:

1. The accreditation granted shall be valid for three (3) years, as specified in the Certificate of Accreditation, unless earlier withdrawn by the Commission;
2. The Council for the Restoration of Filipino Values (CRFV) shall be authorized to conduct programs within its area or field/s of expertise as specified in the Certificate of Accreditation;
3. Within the validity period of its accreditation, CRFV, shall be included in the CSC Roster of Active Accredited Learning and Development Institutions which is published annually;
4. CRFV is authorized to carry the phrase "CSC Accredited Learning and Development Institutions" in its collaterals;
5. To avoid conflicts of interest, Board Members of CRFV who are connected with government agencies shall not directly engage in learning and development activities or consultancy services with the agencies they are connected with; and






