1. Each contestant is free to choose any song provided it is appropriate to special children.
2. Performance time is 2-3 minutes including entrance and exit.
3. Minus-one music or live piano or guitar can be used as accompaniment: however, contestants are allowed to sing without accompaniment.

General Guidelines for the Conduct of the Division National Disability Prevention and Rehabilitation (NDPR) Week on July 29, 2017

1. Each SPED Center/Class in the district shall conduct their own competitions to select the best contestants in all categories.
2. Participants to this competition are currently enrolled in a SPED center or class both in elementary and secondary.
3. A contestant is allowed to participate in only one category.
4. The number of contestants in the registration form shall be his/her official number during the contest.
5. The coaches are reminded to secure duly signed permits from parents regarding their children's participation to the said contests.
6. Mechanics in the conduct of the contest per category is to be followed strictly.
Winners per category will be identified per criteria by the Board of Judges.
7. All winners will receive medals- 1st gold, 2nd silver, 3rd bronze.
8. The panel of judges shall be composed of a Chairman and 2 members. The decision of the board of judges is final.
