General Guidelines for the Conduct of the Division Kinder Day 2017

1. Each District shall conduct their own competition to select the best contestants in all categories.
2. Participants to this competition are currently enrolled Kindergarten pupils in public schools aged 5 and about to be 6 years old on or before November 2017.
3. A contestant is allowed to participate in only one category.
4. Only the **Congressional district** champions in public and private schools per category are qualified to join the contest.
5. Coach in each category is required to submit a Xerox copy of contestant's birth certificate and certification from the principal that the child is currently enrolled in the school and parents permit on the day of the contest.
6. The number of contestants in the registration form shall be his/her official number during the contest.
7. There will be only one piece for storytelling (MTB), and one theme for drawing while the contestants in vocal solo, nursery rhyme recitation (MTB) and Chamber Theater (MTB) are given the freedom to choose their piece.
8. Mechanics in the conduct of the contest per category is to be followed strictly. Winners per category will be identified per criteria by the Board of Judges.
9. All winners in private and public will be determined thru ranking system.
10. All winners will receive medals- 1st gold, 2nd silver, 3rd bronze.
11. The panel of judges shall be composed of a Chairman and 2 members. The decision of the board of judges is final.

VOCAL SOLO COMPETITION

- a. Each contestant is free to choose any O.P.M. song appropriate to children.
- b. Performance time is 2-3 minutes including entrance and exit.
- c. Minus-one music should be used as accompaniment.

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CREATIVE DANCE COMPETITION

1. The group is composed of three (3) pairs, 3 males & 3 females.
2. Each participating group will create a dance depicting a certain sports of their choice. Example if they choose basketball, their steps should include dribbling, shooting, throwing and catching.
3. Time of performance should not exceed 5 minutes including entrance % exit.
4. Props should be naturally placed on stage during the performance.

1. Contestants will be gathered in the assigned room.
2. Coaches & parents are not allowed to mingle with the contestant as the competition starts.
3. The contest has 3 levels.
 - 3.1. Easy
 - 3.2. Average
 - 3.3. Difficult

Easy – The child will identify/tell the color presented by the judge.

Average – The child will identify/tell the shape

Difficult – The child will identify/tell the number figure (1-10)
4. The winner will be chosen by the panel of judges based on the over-all result.

DUET COMPETITION

- Each contestant is free to choose any O.P.M. song appropriate to children.
- Performance time is 2-3 minutes including entrance and exit.
- Minus-one music should be used as accompaniment.
