

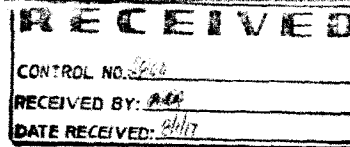
In view thereof may we request your good office that this conference endorsed the different divisions in your region and that participants be allowed to attend on official business.

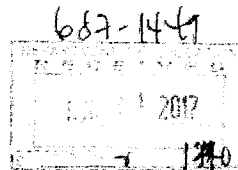
