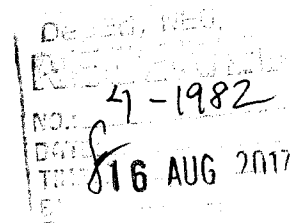

1. Negros Island Region ON-THE-SPOT INTERSCHOOL ART CONTEST CATEGORIES
 - a. Elementary Category (Grades 1 – 6)
 - b. High School Category (Grades 7 – 12)
 - c. Tertiary Category (College/University)
2. Interested participants may fill-out the (downloadable) application form available at victoriasmilling.com. Registrants are required to upload a snapshot of a previous work to complete their registration.
3. Email the filled out application form and sample work at vmcart@yahoo.com and vmcartcontest@gmail.com on or before September 9, 2016
4. All participants must be endorsed by their respective School's representative
5. Only the participants and authorized members of VMC are allowed in the competition area while the contest is on-going. No gadgets are allowed inside the competition area.
6. Medium to be used per category:
 - a. Elementary Category (Grades 1 to 6) – oil pastel on board/acrylic colors on canvas
 - b. High School Category (Grades 7 to 12) – acrylic colors on canvas
 - c. Tertiary Category – acrylic colors on canvas

*Canvas and art materials c/o VMC. Contestants are allowed to bring their favourite art materials with them.
7. Criteria:
 - a. Originality
 - b. Relevance to the Theme
 - c. Handling of Medium
 - d. Over-all impact
8. Judging:
 - a. Registration entries: A maximum of 30 Finalists per category for the On-the-Spot contest will be selected based on the registration form and sample artwork submitted
 - b. On-the-Spot contest: 5 finalists per category will be selected immediately after the On-the-Spot contest on September 22, 2017 in Bacolod City.
