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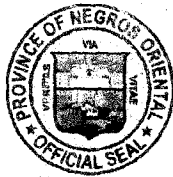
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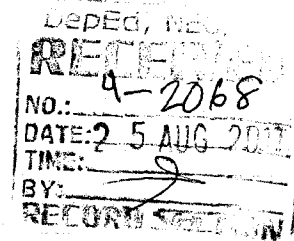

4. Each band shall be composed of twenty (20) or more **Playing** and **Non-Playing Members**.
5. Use of electronic/electrically-amplified instruments is not allowed.
6. The use of the Philippine flag is not allowed in the competition.
7. The use of live animals, mechanized vehicles, pyrotechnics and firearms is not permitted.
8. Each contingent shall wear their proper school band uniform.

Rules and Guidelines

1. The competition is open to all Marching Bands of Universities/Colleges in the Province of Negros Oriental.
2. Only the first 10 participating bands that submitted the duly accomplished entry forms with the supporting document shall be qualified to join the competition.
3. The band shall be judged during its participation (showdown) in the Inter-Collegiate March Band Competition at **9 a.m. Friday, October 13, 2017** at the **Macias Sports Center**. However, if majority of the participating bands are not available, they shall be judged during their participation. *in the parade in the afternoon.*
4. Each band shall be composed of not less than **20 playing and non-playing members**.
 - Composite membership of High School and College students is allowed
5. Use of electronic/electrically-amplified instruments is not allowed.
6. The use of the Philippine Flag is not allowed in the competition.
7. The use of live animals, mechanized vehicles, pyrotechnics and firearms is not permitted.
8. Each contingent shall wear their proper school band uniform.
9. The order of performance will be determined by drawing of lots 30 minutes before the start of the showdown.
10. Repertoire consist of the following:
 - 1 contest piece (Handumanan Medley) without drill * to be provided by the committee, upon confirmation of participation.**
 - 1 marching piece with drill**
 - 1 pop piece with choreo**
11. Competing bands will be judged on the following criteria:

Tone Quality	25 %
Musicality (interpretation, harmony, rhythm, dynamics & intonation)	25 %
Marching Discipline (style, cadence, discipline)	20 %
Repertoire (selection, production design, level of difficulty)	15 %
Uniform	10 %
Over-all Impact	5 %

12. Prizes at stake are:

First Prize	P15,000.00 and trophy
Second Prize	12,000.00 and trophy
Third Prize	8,000.00 and trophy
Consolation Prizes	3,000.00

13. The decision of the Panel of Judges is final.
14. **Performance time is 8-15 minutes.** For every minute of undertime/overtime, 1 point deduction will be imposed on the total score.
15. Duly Accomplished Entry Form must be submitted to the Marching Band Competition Committee on or before **4:00 p.m., Friday, September 22, 2017.**
