Inter-High School Information and Communication Technology (ICT) Quiz Bowl

CONTEST MECHANICS

1. A school is allowed to send only one team comprising of two bonafide students. The team should have a coach or adviser.
2. The team members must present and wear their school ID during the contest.
3. Coverage of the Quiz
 - IT Fundamentals or Computer Trivia
 - Principles of Programming
 - Programming Languages
 - Data Communications and Computer Networks
 - Management Information Systems
 - Databases
 - Computer Security and Ethics
4. Categories, Points and Time Allotted to Answer Questions:
 - Easy (3 points; 20 seconds)
 - Average (5 points; 30 seconds)
 - Difficult (7 points; 50 seconds)
5. Questions are in multiple choice and identification format. The team will choose the best answer from among the choices given by raising the letter corresponding to their answer.
6. The quizmaster shall read the question twice, and the time starts. The team shall only raise their answers after the allotted time (depending on the category) and after the judge signals and says "Answer up".
7. The team with the highest points after the three rounds shall be declared CHAMPION; the second highest points, 1st Runner Up and the third highest points, 2nd Runner Up.
8. In case of a tie in the top three, clincher questions shall be given to break the tie.
9. Any dispute on the question must be channeled by the adviser to the judges for the resolution before the proceeding to the next question.
10. The decision of the board of judges is final and irrevocable.
