**Buglasan Education Environment Tourism  
(BEET) STREET PARADE  
October 13, 2017, 2:30 PM**

**Rules and Guidelines**

1. Participants in this street parade competition are from Public Schools of the Province of Negros Oriental. Participants in this street parade are the seven (7) official entries particularly the Metro Dumaguete areas from the public schools of the Province of Negros Oriental.
2. Each parade contingent will provide a decorated float promoting environmental advocacy. The school/district beauties will board the float.
3. Each parade participating unit will have at least 50 but not more than 100 accompanying contingent composed of teachers, parents and school children.
4. In order to promote the horse-drawn Tartanilla, each participating unit is enjoined to include in its contingent a decorated one.
5. Contestants may use indigenous or recyclable materials for their costumes/attire appropriate to the occasion.
6. Participating contingents are given the choice whether to perform or not in the street parade, however its steps must be in forward movement. Contingents will perform in front of the reviewing stand at the Capitol Area along the national highway fronting the flagpole for a 2 minute courtesy gesture of acknowledging the guests.
7. School Bands and the like (ex. Banda Manga) is optional, however its participation will form part of the whole contingent.
8. The assembly area for the BEET contingents is at Burgos Street Dgte. City at 1:00 PM. The kick-off is at 2:30 PM.
9. Prizes are as follows:

Grand Champion	- P12,000.00 and trophy
1 <sup>st</sup> Runner-up	- P11,000.00 and trophy
2 <sup>nd</sup> Runner-up	- P10,000.00 and trophy
Consolation Prizes	- P 8,000.00 Per Participant
10. The criteria are as follows:

Originality	30%
Artistic Design	30%
Green Motif	20%
X-factor	10%
General Effect	<u>10%</u>
<b>Total</b>	<b>100%</b>
