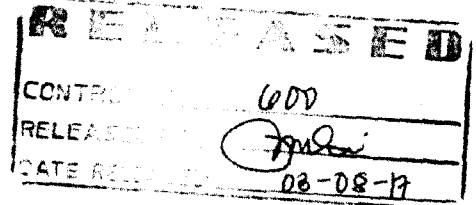

**NEGROS ISLAND REGION CONCENTRATION TRAINING OF ATHLETES, COACHES AND
OFFICIALS IN PREPATION FOR PALARONG PAMBANSA 2017**

All School Division Superintendents
All Heads of Private Schools
All Elementary and Secondary School Heads
All Concerned

1. In order to prepare the Negros Island Region (NIR) contingent to the 2017 Palarong Pambansa in Antique on April 23-29, 2017, a concentration and training of selected athletes, coaches and officials will be conducted from March 13 to April 12, 2017 at Panaad Park and Stadium, Bacolod City and at the Schools/divisions of the winning coaches or teams. There will be a three (3) day break to observe the holy week.
2. Selected athletes from other schools/divisions will report to the winning teams and shall be taken cared by the host coaches/principals/division sports coordinators. Food and incidental expenses for the concentration and trainings shall be taken from their respective SEF/division funds or in any other sources of funds of the host/winning team subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Two (2) round trip transportation expenses of the selected athletes and coaches and officials to attend concentration and trainings from the school of origin to the venue and vice versa shall be chargeable against their respective SEF/school/division funds and to other source of funds that may be available for this purpose. The timetable for the concentration and trainings is herein attached.
3. Selected athletes who will be out from their respective schools shall continue to attend classes in the schools where they are temporarily billeted together with their team mates. Graduating pupils/students and candidates for honors may be given advance test before they report to the training venue or may report after the final examination. The grades of selected athletes shall either be retained or increased depending on their performance in the test during the training period but not be lowered or failed.
