- 1. This is pursuant to Presidential Proclamation Nos. 224 and 227 s. 1998 and Republic Act (RA) No. 6469. The Philippine Commission on Women (PCW) leads the annual National Women's Month Celebration (NWMC) in March of every year.
- 2. This year's theme is We Make Change Work for Women. Being the first NWMC under the new administration, the theme is aligned with the tagline and commitment Malasakit at Pagbabago or True Compassion and Real Change. The NWMC theme emphasizes that women should be active drivers in bringing about positive changes and that they should also reap from development efforts. This can be made possible by empowering women-enabling them to meaningfully engage with other development stakeholders, and by fully implementing the Magna Carta of Women (RA 9710), which is also one of the directives on the President's first State of the Nation Address (SONA).
- 3. To promote public awareness in the celebration of the event, all DepEd offices, including the regional and schools division offices and schools are encouraged to undertake the following related activities:

a. Production of Information, Education and Communication (IEC) Materials

- i. hanging of 2017 NWMC official streamer in all government agencies including central, regional, and schools division offices and schools; and
- ii. development, production and distribution of IEC materials for 2017 NWMC which include collaterals designed by PCW and agency-specific materials like flyers that feature agency services offered to their women clients. Schools can develop their own IEC materials provided that they features accomplishments and plans on gender and development.

b. Participation to Women's Month Online Advocacy

- uploading of the official logo, advocacy video and other National Women's Month advocacy materials in schools' website and social media accounts;
- ii. participating in the online campaign thread about the observance by uploading photos, news features and other information relative to NWMC 2017, gender and development (GAD), and the Magna Carta of Women using the hashtag #WomenMakeChange;
- iii. enjoining DepEd offices personnel, teaching and non-teaching staff of schools, students, and parents to participate in the online advocacy: #BilangBabae I am a #PartnerForChange from March 1 to 20. Said online advocacy is a PCW initiative through social media enjoining women netizens to share their idea of change and how they see themselves contributing to achieve that change. All they have to do is post a photo of themselves via Facebook using the hashtag: #BilangBabae and #partnerforchange. PCW will randomly select from pre-evaluated posts recipients of special prizes as simple token of appreciation for joining the online initiative. - iv. featuring calendar of activities and activity implementation reports of DepEd offices and schools, as well as Women's Month advocacy materials in their official websites, social media accounts and publications, and sending links to the reports to PCW through e-mail events.pcw@gmail.com; and

Background

#BilangBabae is an online advocacy initiative of the Philippine Commission on Women for the 2017 National Women's Month Celebration.

It aims to gather women netizen's perspectives on two things: (1) the changes that they want to see relative to women's issues and concerns, and (2) how they see themselves contributing to make these changes happen.

The initiative will use Facebook as a platform using the hashtags #BilangBabae and #PartnerForChange.

Posts/entries will be gathered from March 1 to 20, 2017. These will be consolidated through a video montage which PCW will feature in its official social media accounts and during the Women's Summit on March 30-31, 2017. PCW will randomly select from pre-evaluated entries 20 winners of special prizes as simple token for participating in the activity.

Mechanics

1. #BilangBabae is open to all Filipino women and girls who own a Facebook account. Please know that Facebook requires everyone to be at least 13 years old before they can create an account (in some jurisdictions, this age limit may be higher). Participating individuals must comply and adhere to the rules of the social networking site. If you do not have a Facebook account, it is free to create one at www.facebook.com.

- 2. Post your selfie/photo montage/portrait photo and complete the statement: #BilangBabae gusto ko na <statement on the changes that you want to see or issues that you want to be addressed>. Magiging #PartnerForChange ako sa pamamagitan ng <state what you are willing to contribute or do to make these changes happen>.
- 3. To make your entry valid, like PCW's official Facebook page <u>www.facebook.com/PCWgovph</u> and do not forget to use hashtags #BilangBabae and #PartnerForChange.
- 4. Make sure that your post is set to "public" so people can view your entry.
- 5. Make sure that you would only post your own photo and not somebody else's picture.
- 6. Please note that pre-selected entries will be uploaded in PCW's Facebook account. By joining the #BilangBabae contest, you grant PCW the permission to post your photo and name in its social media handles, website and other advocacy activities relative to its causes.
- 7. Make sure that you follow PCW's official Facebook account to check if your entry has been preselected for inclusion in the video montage and the raffle of prizes.
- 8. Only valid entries posted until March 20, 2017 (6:00 PM, Philippine Standard Time) shall be included in the video montage and in drawing of 20 prize winners.
- 9. Winners shall be notified by PCW through a private message in Facebook.
