

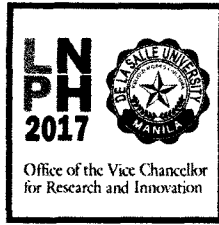
The Conference-Workshop-Seminar aims to:

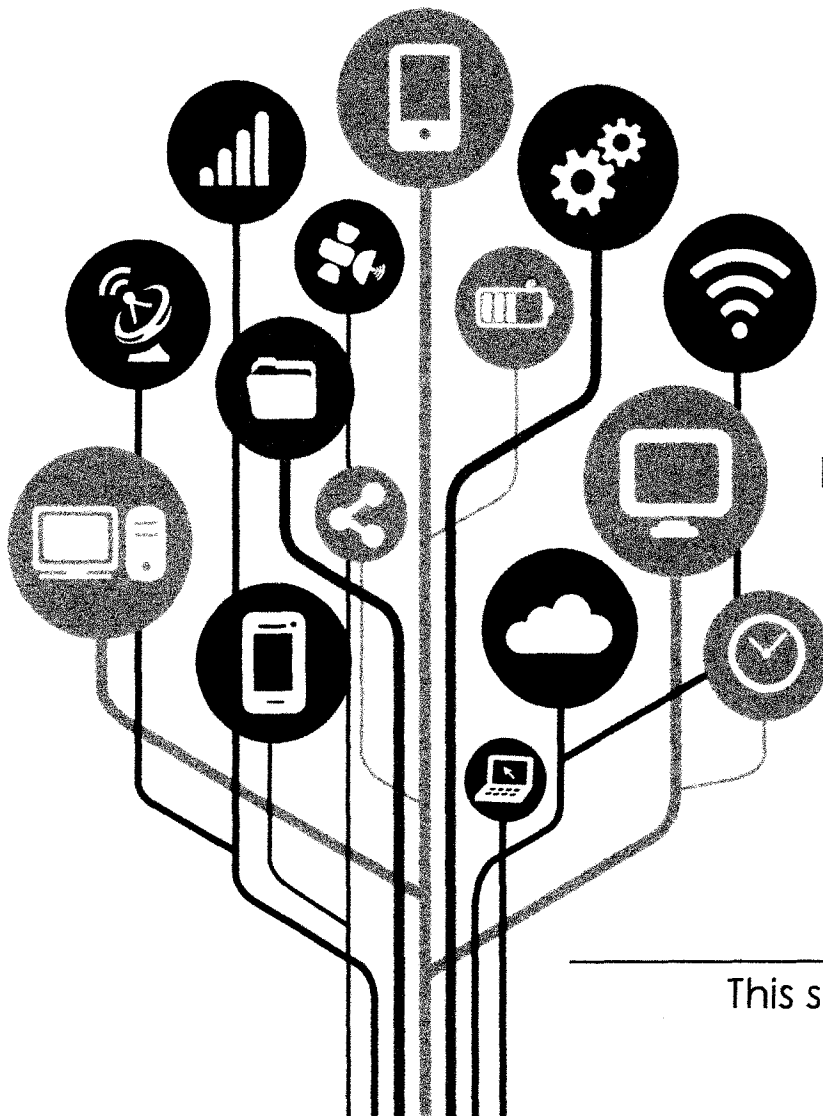
