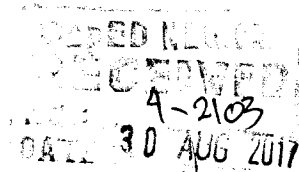

Guidelines

1. There are no limits to the number of participants for the Ukulele Ensemble
2. Membership of the Ukulele Ensemble is open to parents, teachers, pupils/students and out-of-school children and youth.
3. Each contestant will play any Filipino Nursery Rhyme as one of the contest piece, not to exceed two (2) minutes with choreography appropriate to the musical piece. Ex. May Tatlong Bebe
4. Each contestant will perform another one Filipino music of their choice not to exceed three (3) minutes.
5. Contestants must represent their respective Local Government Units.
6. Contestants are enjoined to wear costumes approximate to the competition.
7. The criteria are as follows:

A. Harmony (Blending)	20%
B. Tonal Quality (volume,dynamics)	30%
C. Musicianship (Showmanship, craft interpretation)	30%
D. General Effect (X-Factor, appropriations of attitude, stage deportment, audience appeal, organization)	20%
Total	100%

8. Prizes are as follows:

Champion	P 15,000.00 and trophy
1 st Runner-up	P 10,000.00 and trophy
2 nd Runner-up	P 5,000.00 and trophy
Consolation Prize	P 3,000.00 each

The decision of the Board of Judges is final and irrevocable.

- Rehearsals all contestants – Starting 09:00 AM, Saturday, October 14, 2017.

Children's Choir Competition

RULES AND GUIDELINES

A. Eligibility and Membership

The competition is open to all children 6 – 12 years old who are Filipino citizens. Choir membership shall not be less than twenty-five (25) and not more than thirty (30) singers, one (1) conductor and not more than two (2) accompanists. The choir shall be accompanied by either guitar/s and/or piano. Conductor and choir members can perform with only one (1) choir.

B. Application and Registration

Schools shall be encouraged to enter their choir.

Participating choir must submit to the Committee at the Provincial Tourism Office not later than 04:00 PM, Friday, September 15, 2017, the following:

- ❖ Entry Form duly accomplished.
- ❖ One (1) copy of the certified list of names and birthdates of choir members, and
- ❖ Three (3) copies of the actual musical scores.

C. Repertoire

The Choir shall choose its own repertoire provided that these shall be Original Pilipino Music (OPM), one in English and another in any Philippine dialect.

Pieces must be composed or arranged for SSA (Soprano 1, Soprano 11, and Alto).

D. Performance

Participating choirs must come to the competition in proper attire.

All songs shall be memorized. No choreography or body movement is allowed unless specified in the score. Changing choral formation to suit the sound or context of a work is allowed provided it is done between renditions.

Singing time for each choir is limited to five (5) minutes, excluding entrance and exit.

No sets, backdrop and hand props will be allowed.

The decision of the Panel of Judges will be considered final and un-appealable.

E. Criteria

Voice Quality (Tonal Quality, Projection)	40%
Musicianship (Dynamics, Rhythm, Style)	30%
Diction (Clarity, Phrasing)	20%
Stage Deportment (Grooming, Discipline)	10%

F. Prizes

First Prize	₱15,000.00 and trophy
Second Prize	₱10,000.00 and trophy
Third Prize	₱8,000.00 and trophy
Consolation prizes for non-winners	₱3,000.00 each

G. Only the first 8 (eight) to submit duly accomplished Entry Forms will be qualified to join the competition.
