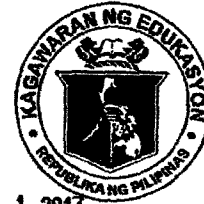

BRIGADA ESKWELA SA MARAWI CITY: ANNOUNCING THE PAIRED / TWINNED MARAWI SCHOOLS WITH SCHOOLS DIVISIONS OF REGION VII

TO: Schools Division / City Superintendents
 Officers-in-Charge of Regular / Interim Divisions

- In light of the progress report of the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) regarding the security and peace and order situation in Marawi City, the Department of Education (DepEd) announces education support per UnNumbered Memorandum dated September 4, 2017 signed by Undersecretary Alain Del B. Pascua by conducting a Brigada Eskwela sa Marawi City ("Bagon Marawi").
- Each Division under DepED ARMM is partnered with a Mindanao Regional Office to handle one of the five sectors and the schools under the sectors are paired with the Division Offices of these Mindanao regions. The ARMM SDOs and Mindanao ROs and SDOs are then twinned with a Luzon and Visayas ROs and DOs.
- Twelve schools of Sector-1 have been cleared by the AFP to open classes on September 5, 2017 and their Bagon Marawi Brigada Eskwela will be conducted on October 9-10, 2017 to give enough time for the paired and twinned regions and divisions to mobilize necessary support for repair and clean-up.

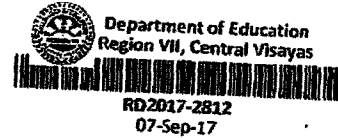

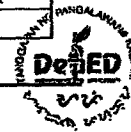
