## ORIENTATION AND IMPLEMENTATION OF COMPREHENSIVE SCHOOL SAFETY (CSS) MONITORING TOOL

- In light of promoting resilience education and the need to strengthen implementation of Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM) at the school level, the Division DRRM Office shall conduct Orientation and Implementation of Comprehensive School Safety (CSS) Monitoring Tool to gather data, information and feedback on October 7-8, 2017 at SIbulan Central Elementary School Conference Room.
- 2. The school level Comprehensive School Safety Monitoring Tool aims to:
  - a) Establish the baseline with respect to the implementation of the 3 Pillars of DepEd's Comprehensive DRRM in Education Framework (DO 37, s. 2015);
  - b) Set the school's DRRM targets for 3 years, based on the baseline;
  - c) Track the annual progress of the school with respects to its targets.
