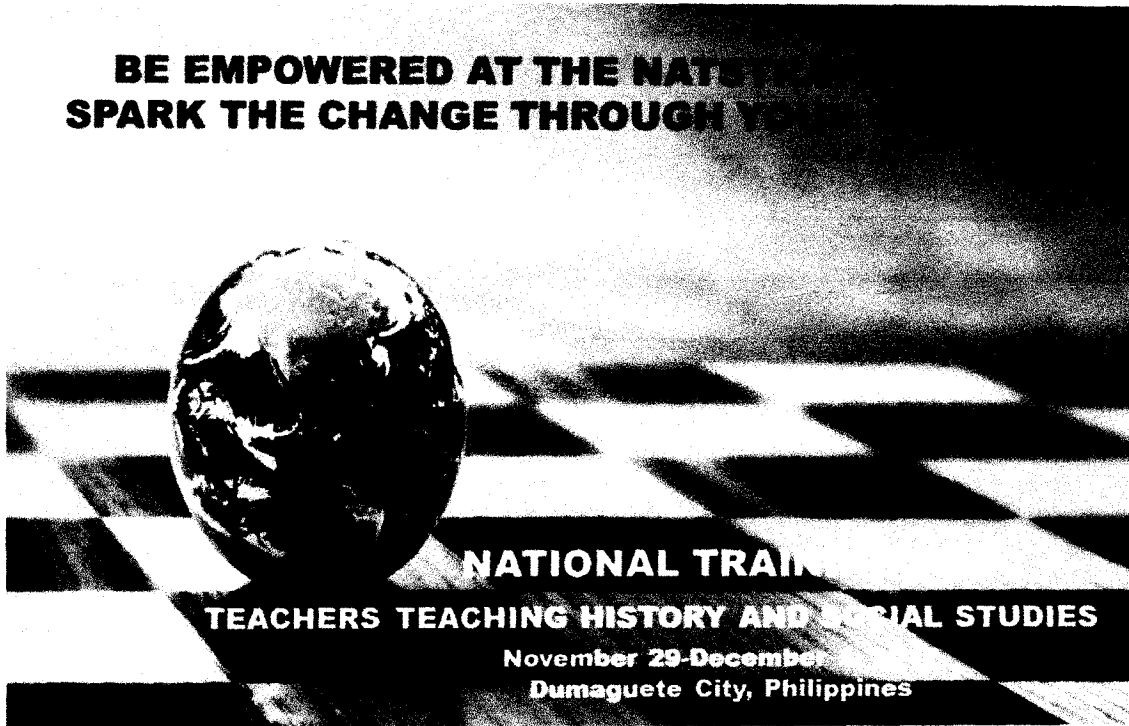

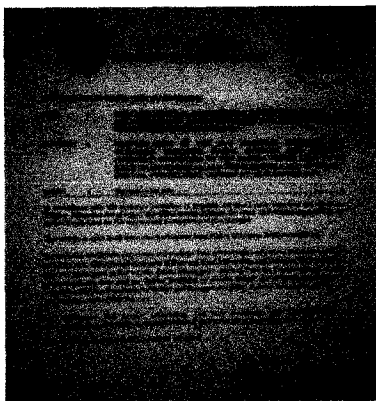

BRIEF DESCRIPTION:

The 2017 NATSTRAT is a 3-day intensive program, emphasizes on necessary, beneficial and practical approaches to better social studies and history teaching through key techniques and strategies from one's intelligences, skills and values blended with leadership development concepts.

The intensive program will explore analytical frameworks employing the leadership and current strategies and techniques in understanding History and with proper decision making skills and balance, we avoid the mistakes of the past as move forward to a better Philippines and World! Participants will build skills and refine values as they perform team exercises which will provide greater inspiration for the self to effect change in the families, communities and the nation using Aral Panlipunan, Social Science and History as a subjects.

TARGET PARTICIPANTS AND NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS:

The participants are teachers handling Araling Panlipunan and Social Studies from Grade 1-12 and teachers in the private schools; Social Science and History Lecturers;

I. RATIONALE:

Saceda Youth Lead builds leadership through education and action. For 19 years now, it continues empowering elementary, high school and college students and even teachers to become most effective citizens by providing them opportunities in leadership, community service and exchange. As part of our greater commitment to national development, we organize several leadership development trainings in the Philippines, ASEAN and the West African regions. One of these is the 2017 National Training for Teachers Teaching Social Studies and History (NATSTRAT) which is held every November of the year.

4. To develop an appreciation on the importance of teaching correctly Aral Pan and History especially in the Grades 5/6 Philippine History Curriculum



THE VENUE

All events and programs of the 2017 NATSTRAT will be held at the SYL Center, Purok Likod, Brgy. Candauay 6200 Dumaguete City, Philippines.



Our center is located 7 kilometers west of Dumaguete and is very accessible by public transport (the Pedicab). From the city, take a pedicab to the Candauay Terminal located at the Public Market II. The fare is only P12. The pedicab will take you directly to the SYL Center.

If you plan to take a pedicab directly, the minimum fare (pakyaw) is P70-P100.

The center is equipped with paramedics and physicians and we are 10 minutes away from 3 major hospitals in Dumaguete. (Negros Oriental Provincial Hospital, Silliman University Medical Hospital and Holy Child Hospital)

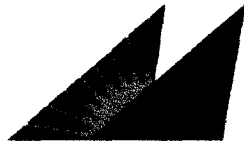

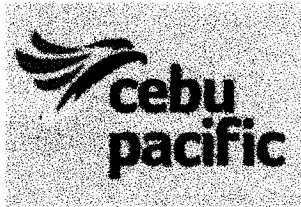

Dumaguete is serviced by Philippine Airlines and Cebu Pacific Airways. Please contact your travel agency to check on fares.

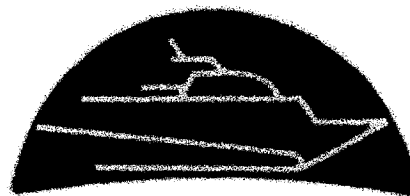
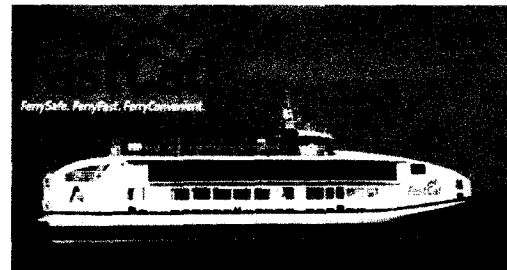
