Greetings!

The History Department of the University of Asia and the Pacific (UA&P), invites you to a seminar-workshop on "Teaching Rizal's Noli Me Tangere and El Filibusterismo for Wisdom and Citizenship in the K to 12 Curriculum: THE LIFE OF JOSE RIZAL DURING THE WRITING OF HIS TWO NOVELS." The activity will be held on April 26-28, 2017 (Wednesday to Friday) at the Telengtan Hall, University of Asia and the Pacific campus, Pearl Drive, Ortigas Center, Pasig City.

This activity is the second of our three-year series on "Teaching Rizal's *Noli Me Tangere* and *El Filibusterismo* for Wisdom and Citizenship in the K to 12 Curriculum." The first seminar-workshop, held successfully last April 2016, focused on the 'Historical Context Behind Rizal's Noli Me Tangere and El Filibusterismo.'

This seminar-workshop will be relevant to the Filipino and Social Studies teachers from Grades 6 to 10 who teach Philippine History as well as the two novels of our national hero – the *Noli Me Tangere and El Filibusterismo*. The objectives of the seminar-workshop are:

- 1. To develop correct and deeper understanding of the historical background behind Rizal's novels in order for teachers to have strong and integral understanding of historical concepts, themes, and issues in history and historiography;
- 2. To demonstrate some of the best practices in teaching approaches and assessment tools used in these subjects; and
- 3. To illustrate how the learners can use critical analysis, academic reasoning, and practice responsible citizenship and civic virtues.

Highly accomplished members of the UA&P History Department, Dr. Paul A. Dumol, Dr. Clement C. Camposano, Dr. Marya Svetlana T. Camacho, and Dr. Arnel E. Joven will give the lectures for our activity. They will be present to guide and moderate the workshop sessions as well.

The registration fee is Php3,500. For those who want to avail of the <u>early bird rate</u> of Php3,200, participants may register on or before <u>27 March 2017</u>. The fee covers the handouts, meals and certificates for the three-day activity. The proposed program for this event and the registration procedures are enclosed in this letter. 
