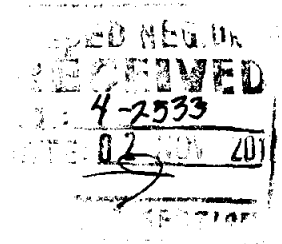

Republic Act No. 10661 declares the month of November of every year as National Children's Month (NCM). This declaration commemorates the adoption of the Convention on the Rights of the Child by the United Nations General Assembly on November 20, 1989.


In line with this declaration, the Child Labor Prevention and Elimination Program (CLPEP) - Negros Oriental Field Office of the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) Regional Office No. 7 will conduct a half-day activity that will instill a significant and meaningful commemoration of the National Children's Month in relation to child labor and human trafficking.
