The Presbyterian Theological College of Cantil-e, Dumaguete City has entered into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Schools Division Office of the Division of Negros Oriental per Joint CHED & DepEd Order on the Guidelines in the Deployment of Pre-Service Teachers on Experiential Learning: Field Study & Practice Teaching.

School Principals concerned through the Public Schools District Supervisors are expected to facilitate deployment of these student teachers and must observe the following:

- 1. Assign a student teacher to a qualified cooperating teacher in coordination with the school department head/chairman and with the University/College Student Teaching Supervisor/Director;
- 2. Conduct regular conference with the cooperating teachers as regards the performance of the student teachers;
- 3. Coordinate with the college supervisor of the student teacher;
- 4. See to it that student teachers are not allowed to substitute for teachers who are on leave;
- 5. Prepare required reports to the Schook Division Superintendent.

Only student teachers whose names are in the enclosed list in this division memorandum shall be accommodated in the schools where they shall be assigned upon presentation of a **CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION** as a proof that they have attended the orientation conducted by the Schools Division Office as a requirement per CHED & DepEd Joint Memorandum.

### No student teachers shall be assigned in Senior High School classes.

Enclosed is a copy of LET Majorship Guide for Non-Education Bachelor's Degree with 18 Units of Professional Education from the PRC as guide for School Principals to appropriately assign a student teacher during actual student teaching.

Should issues arise regarding field study students, the concerned schools may refer these to this office (AttrDr. Erlinda N. Calumpang, Chief, Curriculum Implementation Division).
