Check in date is afternoon of July 30, 2017 and first meal is dinner of the said date. Last meal is August 3, 2017.





The first meal to be served is dinner on July 30, 2017 and last meal for the LRE participants will be lunch on August 3, 2017. All participants should bring their signed Travel Order and other documents needed.


