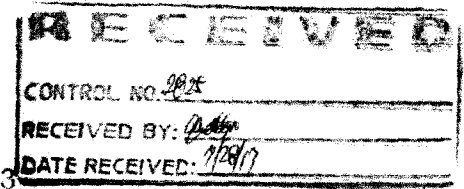

The Philippine Home Economics Association (PHEA) will hold its *69th National Conference and Training* with the theme *Tradition and Innovation: Home Economics Challenges for Sustainable Living* from October 13 to 15, 2017 at the Bohol Tropics Resort, Graham Avenue, Tagbilaran City, Bohol.

The Conference aims to:

1. ensure the provision of comprehensive and in-depth information on the new Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE) and *Edukasyong Pantahanan at Pangkabuhayan* (EPP) Curriculum under the Expanded Basic Education Program (EBEP);
2. provide the participants with updates on EPP Grade IV and Senior High School (SHS) Curriculum and Technical-Vocational-Livelihood (TVL) track;
3. conduct hands-on Training on mini courses aligned with the Technical Education Skills Development Authority (TESDA) accreditation for National Certificate (NC II) or (NC III); and
