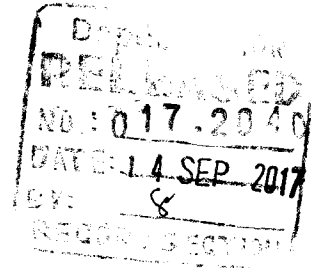

SUBJECT : Nationwide Orientation-Workshop for DepEd CLMD, CID, and LRMDS Chiefs on the use of Basa Pilipinas materials in the DepEd Learning Resource Portal

DATE : June 21, 2017

1. The DepEd-USAID Basa Pilipinas program has been working with DepEd on improving early grades language and literacy instruction since 2013. While program activities are directly implemented in eight divisions in Regions I and II, the DepEd- approved Basa Pilipinas Grades 1 and 3 language and literacy materials may be used by divisions and schools across the country. DepEd requested that these materials be shared more broadly to all schools via the DepEd Learning Resource Portal, where Basa materials have already been uploaded. These materials include DepEd-approved Revised Teacher Guides and Levelled Readers for Filipino, English, and two Mother Tongues (Sinugbuanong Binsaya and Ilokano); Multi-grade Outlines to guide multigrade schools on the use of these classroom instruction materials; Learning Action Cell (LAC) Session guides focused on early grades literacy and training videos on relevant language and literacy instruction topics.
2. To enable DepEd divisions nationwide to learn more about these Basa Pilipinas early grades literacy instruction materials, Basa Pilipinas will conduct orientation-workshops for all DepEd regions and divisions this September 2017. Participants will include all regional CLMD Chiefs, Division CID Chiefs, and Division LRMDS Chiefs (or their designated representative).
3. Basa Pilipinas will cover the cost of participants' travel, meals, and accommodation during these events.

Basa Pilipinas is an early grades reading program partnership between the Department of Education and USAID in support of DepEd's K-12 reforms for mother tongue-based multilingual education and the integrated language arts curriculum. It is being implemented in the DepEd school divisions of Ilocos Norte, Ilocos Sur, La Union, San Fernando City, Cebu, Mandaue City, Bohol, and Tagbilaran City.
