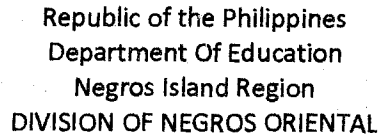

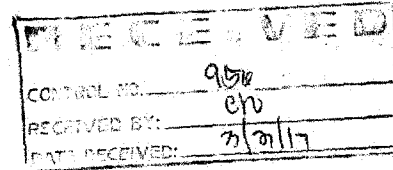

ORGANIZATIONS AND OTHER ORGANIZED GROUPS

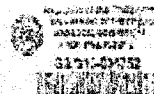
Department Memorandum Circular No. 95-167 dated September 5, 1995, entitled, *Policies and Guidelines on the Utilization of Local Funds Relative to the Conventions, Seminars and Similar Activities Conducted by the Associations of Professionals, Foundations, Non-Governmental Organizations and Other Organized Groups*, is hereby repealed.

It is understood that any in-country convention, seminar or training attended by a local government official or employee, with the use of public funds, is within the purview of the Local Development Agenda of the participating local government.

It is further understood that a Provincial Governor, City Mayor, Municipal Mayor or a Punong Barangay, as head of a local government, is principally responsible and accountable for the prudent use of scarce financial resources keeping in mind desired organizational results and development outcomes.

This Memorandum Circular shall take effect immediately.



My warmest greetings to all of you. It is with great pride and honor as your president-elect, to head and organize our 108th PDA Annual Convention.

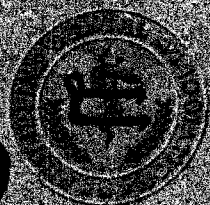
