The Philippine Statistical Association, Inc. (PSAI) is pleased to announce the holding of the 2017 PSAI Annual Conference on *Statistics in Support of the Local Economy* to be held on September 27-29, 2017 at the Sugarland Hotel, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental.

The PSAI is now accepting contributed papers for oral presentation in the Conference. The forum will highlight sharing of experiences in the production and analysis of statistics that support initiatives envisioned to spur the growth of the local economy. Research papers for presentation shall focus on the generation of local level statistics, and applications of statistical methodology and innovative approaches in the production and analysis of data that would translate into doable plans and programs across various sectors. Discussions may include but may not be limited to community-based monitoring systems; spatial analysis of local level data; financial inclusion; small area statistics; poverty analysis; disaster statistics; labor and employment in the local economy; education and the K-12 program; and other relevant topics.

Deadline of submission of abstracts is on 15 July 2017

Participating papers with multiple authors must clearly indicate the author with whom the organizers should exchange correspondence. The abstract should contain 200 to 300 words, English in MS Word Times New Roman 12 format, typed double-space on A4 paper size with 1 inch margins on all sides.

The Scientific Program Committee, in consultation with the PSAI Executive Committee, will screen applications for paper presentation based on the submitted abstracts. Abstracts will be evaluated and authors of the accepted papers for presentation shall be informed by 31 July 2017. Authors of selected papers for presentation shall submit the full paper by email not later than 15 August 2017. Final manuscripts must not exceed 5,000 words, English, single space in A4-sized pages using 12-point Times New Roman font in MS-Word format. Additional instructions will be given to the authors of selected papers. The final manuscripts must be submitted to the Chair of the Scientific Program Committee and the PSAI Secretariat.

All papers accepted and received by the Committee and the Secretariat on or before 15 August 2017 will be included in the PSAI Annual Conference 2017 ecompilation of papers.
