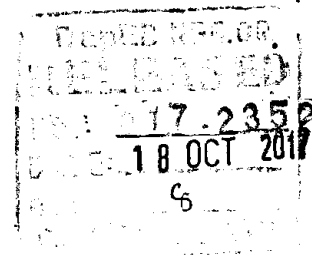

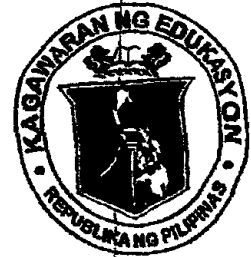

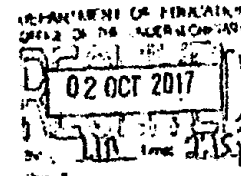

The Department of Education through the Bureau of Learning Delivery - Student Inclusion Division (BLD-SID) will hold the National Conference on Inclusive Education in Basic Education with the theme *"Teaching and Learning Together: Toward Education For All"*. This conference will be conducted on October 18-20, 2017 in Cebu City at a venue to be announced later for the Visayas and Mindanao cluster and on October 25-27, 2017 at Ariana Hotel, Parangao, Bauang, La Union, for the Luzon cluster.

2. The conference aims to provide policy and programs updates on inclusive education in the K to 12; enhance the knowledge and skills of participants in managing an inclusive school; and to provide opportunities to share best practices in teaching learners in an inclusive classroom setting.

3.
